Winun Ngari Aboriginal Corporation (WNAC) is the largest community development provider for remote Aboriginal communities in the West Kimberley.

In addition to serving communities in and around Derby, we serve several remote communities located along the Gibb River Road, and Looma (including surrounding communities). Counting the town site of Derby, WNAC covers an estimated population of approximately 4,400 people from a range of age groups.

The support WNAC provides to remote communities differs from community to community, however services include enterprise and business development, employment and training, health and well-being, governance and administration.

PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE

DERBY AIRPORT REDEVELOPMENT

Winun Ngari Employment Services

Funding was secured to upgrade the Derby Airport terminal as a three-way partnership between the Shire of Derby West Kimberley, H&M Tracy and Winun Ngari Aboriginal Corporation. A Work Ready program was developed and delivered on site. Work undertaken in partnership included:

- » Trench preparation for installation of services (power, water & sewerage)
- » Removal of asbestos buildings
- » Full-time work for four CDP participants as trades assistants Eight months work for six CDP participants in all aspects on the job

CONSTRUCTION + RELOCATION

Kimberley Building + Maintenance

A range of work completed within Derby and remote communities, including:

- » Renovation of transportables at remote communities, including Kupungarri
- » Construction of a shed at Dodnun community
- » Lining of disused buildings to establish offices and retail shop, and preparing site for power installations
